Rating Guide for Tipton Lakes Athletic Club Junior Instructional Clinics

The following rating guide is designed to assist you in determining your current level of play. Although there are suggested ratings for all classes, each player's ability may vary slightly in level play. A TLAC professional will evaluate each player and admit them into an appropriate clinic level.

***** QUICK START TENNIS PROGRAM *****

Rating 1 *HOTSHOTS, FUTURE STARS, STARBURST and MIDDLE SCHOOL*

These players have had tennis instruction before and are beginning to understand the basic rules, scoring, and terminology of tennis. They may not be playing tennis sets, but they are getting involved in basic fundamentals, game play, and **ralleyball**. They need instruction and practice for learning – and fun.

Rating 2 *CHALLENGERS SHOTMAKER, Group #4*

These advanced elementary school and middle school team players are beginning match play situations and understand scoring, rules, and basic tennis terminology. The program includes stroke development fundamentals, group drills, set play, and game situations. There is more involvement in instruction and practice.

Rating 3: *CONTENDERS GAMEPLAN, Group #3*

These middle school team and high school reserve team players show some of the same qualities as *CHALLENGERS SHOTMAKERS*, but they are not as advanced, consistent, nor competitive. Players are involved in some type of team play and challenge ladder matches. Program includes drill groups, stroke development and play, competitive game situations, and fundamentals.

Rating 4: *ONCOURT EXCELLENCE, Group #2*

These advanced middle school and high school team players should be getting involved with USTA tournament competition, challenge ladder matches, and school varsity team play. The program includes drill groups, stroke development, match strategy, consistency, and conditioning.

Rating 5: *CENTER COURT CHAMPIONS, Group #1*

These top players should be active in USTA tournament competition and strong high school varsity team play. Playing goals include CITA ranking or higher. Program includes technical and competitive skills development, athletic conditioning skills, and advanced fundamentals.
